LITTLE SIR REPORT

Carol Brush, the spouse of fellow member Steve Brush, is actively involved in the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR). One of the many activities of the DAR organization is to pay tribute to our courageous veterans who were part of our country's previous wars and conflicts. During the April meeting, Carol would like to recognize our fellow Branch 23 SIR members who are veterans and who have served our country. At our March meeting I will ask all of you veterans to provide some information regarding your military service, in preparation for the April meeting.

Our speaker for March is Gene Hamner. Gene graduated from Humboldt State University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Forest Management in 1967. The following year he entered the U.S. Air Force, graduating from pilot training at Webb Air Force Base, Texas, in 1970. He then requested an assignment flying Cessna 0-2A's as a Forward Air Controller in Vietnam. He then volunteered to fly the truck interdiction mission on the Ho Chi Minh trail in Laos. In 1971, Gene volunteered for a top secret operation in Laos known as "The Ravens." Gene was "Raven 12." This was from August, 1971 to April, 1972.

In April, 1972, Gene returned to the U.S. and was stationed at McChord AFB, Washington, flying C-141 jet transports. Following his Air Force career, Gene began crop dusting in San Joaquin County in 1975 and retired from flying and crop dusting in 2008. During this time, he owned two crop dusting businesses, Ag-Flight and San Joaquin Air. (Continued on page 3)

While in the Air Force in 1973, Gene married his wife Rebecca. They have a daughter and are proud grandparents of 3 year old twin boys.
