The Monroe Ridge Trail is an easy hike & rated excellent by Alltrails of approximately 3 miles with an elevation gain of 600 feet. It connects the Marshall Monument with the North Beach picnic area at opposite ends of the park. Once you have climbed to the ridge, the trail follows the ridgeline for about a mile providing views of the river and surrounding valleys. The trail runs solely through natural forested areas of manzanita, oak, toyon, and pine.
