On that subject, because of Covid 19, state SIR did not require the normal quarterly assessment last year because the shutdown of SIR activities reduced state costs. I hope you all enjoyed a very informative presentation by Joe Smith, the Advocacy Director for Loaves and Fishes. His story of raising himself from homelessness is the type of success that we all need to appreciate. We also learned that Loaves and Fishes is a much broader, full family service to assist the homeless in advancing their lives and the benefits it provides to the Sacramento region.

Our February speaker is Mr. Taylor Lewis. A highly lauded speaker, he comes to us from UC Davis, where he is the manager of the Arboretum, Nursery, and Public Gardens. Mr. Lewis is a single parent of two daughters and a son, and has two grandchildren. His two younger children are both in college, one at CSU, Humboldt State and the other at CSU, Chico State. Mr. Lewis earned his degree from UC Davis in Urban Forestry and worked in the wholesale and retail nursery business for several years before returning to UCD in 2012. At UCD, he specializes in environmental horticulture, urban forests and drought tolerant plants, focusing on the Sacramento and Central Valleys. He also does consulting as a "Garden Coach" and runs the UCD natural plant nursery where students and volunteers grow regional varieties which locals can buy. These are plants specific to this area which are drought tolerant and are wildlife friendly. His plant website is "arboretum.UCDavis.edu". Mr. Lewis is very engaging and I believe you will enjoy his presentation.

Regarding the upcoming golf season, we should remember a few basics.

- Be there on time. Try to get to the course at least 30-45 minutes before your tee time. Remember, you need to check in at the course starter and also the SIR starter (for your scorecard).
- 2) Stay up with the group in front of you.
- 3) Please do not leave your cart (motorized or push cart) at the front of the green while you are putting out. Leaving it in front of the green causes undo delay for the group behind. Park it to the side or behind the green, preferably on a cart path that leads to the next tee box. Do not leave it where an approach shot from a golfer in the group behind can hit the cart, or worse, someone in your group. Also, if you "top" a shot more than a few yards, do not walk up to the ball, hit it, then walk back to the cart. Move the cart forward, then hit your next shot.
- 4) **Have fun.** It is not life and death out there, at least not until it's 110 degrees, or you have a 4 footer for the pink slip of your classic car on the 18th green. (Ed.)
