Chris Christopherson receives Super Senior Award

Chris Christopherson was awarded the Super Senior award from Big SIR JD Bamfield at the July meeting.

Chris joined Branch 23 in August, 1995. He served as the Sunshine Chairman from 2009 through 2021. Chris is also very active in our golf program, playing in both the 9 and 18 hole leagues. He has probably played more rounds than anyone else in the branch, with the possible exception of Frank Abel.

Interestingly, Chris's father, Henry Christopherson, was a charter member of Branch 23 when it was chartered in 1969.

Chris has had a very interesting life and has covered a lot of the world over his 95 years. Born in Weehawken, N.J., where Captain Sully landed his plane on the Hudson River in 2009, Chris also spent time in Brooklyn, Astoria, and New Hyde Park prior to enlisting in the Navy in 1945. After his discharge, he graduated from Adelphi University and worked at Sperry Gyroscope as an engineer.

He later instructed pilots on F86 aircraft on how to use the latest computing gunsights at various airbases in the United States and Korea.

Later, Chris worked at Aerojet in Rancho Cordova for eight years, developing and testing nuclear rockets.

In 1959, he married Jeanne, also an Aerojet employee. They have two daughters.

When Aerojet laid off approximately 20,000 employees, Chris moved over to McClellan AFB, where he worked on the Space Shuttle and later helped solve a complex problem that was causing the F111 to become uncontrollable and crash. Chris retired from McClellan in 1992, and became a travel agent.

Chris and his wife have traveled all around the world, by both air and sea. They are members of the 100 country club.
