SENIOR AWARD:

Cass Mastalski turned 90 years of age this month, thereby qualifying for the SIR Senior Award. Cass joined Branch 23 in November, 2004, having been sponsored by Chris Christopherson.

Early on, Cass was in the Air Force for four years. After college, Cass married and has been married to his wife, Mary, for over 50 years.

Cass worked at McClellan AFB for 20 years, from 1975 until 1995. Cass was an equipment specialist in the F-111 Systems Management Division. He worked on the F-111 from the first one delivered to McClellan until the plane was retired 20 years later. It seems like the plane and Cass retired at the same time.

During this time period, Cass was sent to Lakenheath Royal AFB near Cambridge, England, for 3 years, overseeing the F-111's that were sent to that location.

While at McClellan AFB, Cass played golf with our Historian, Bill Sutherland. Bill indicated that he and Cass had played in at least three golf leagues over the years. Bill indicated that Cass had previously joined the SIRS Branch, but had no record of his original installation or resignation dates. But Cass did join in 2004 and he has been very active in both the nine and eighteen hole golf leagues. Just since 2005, he has played in over 500 rounds of golf between the two leagues. In 2009, Cass assumed to job of the 18 hole golf chairmanship. This job involves close coordination and signing contracts with the various courses we play throughout the year. Cass did a great job with that position, until replaced by Dave Brunton. A few significant features he brought to the 18 hole program were: One, he increased the number of tournaments from about 22 per year to as many as 35; Two, he was able to schedule our league into several private country clubs, such as Del Paso, Sierra View, and Granite Bay; Third, he initiated the raffle program for donated rounds of golf for a foursome at several courses we play annually, with the raffle proceeds going directly into our prize fund at the end of the year.

"The quality of our golf program today, which is a cornerstone of our branch, can definitely be traced back to the efforts of Cass Mastalski during those 13 years", Bill Sutherland said.

Congratulations to Cass Mastalski on his 90th birthday.
