#### **Little SIR Report:**

Our Guest Speaker for September is our very own Darrell Beddard (aka Big D). Darrell is a licensed Civil and Geotechnical Engineer in the State of California. Darrell was born in Sacramento and lived in North Sacramento until 1996 when he moved to Rocklin. He went to College at Sac State University and graduated in 1985 with a BS in Civil Engineering. In 1984, Darrell went to work part time as a student assistance at Caltrans and started full time upon graduation in 1985.

Darrell said he had a great carrier and got to work on some of the highest profile projects in the last 40 years. Darrell started his career in Geotechnical Engineering and finished in the Architectural and Engineering Contracts unit managing consultant engineering contracts and assisting in office development.

In 1993, Darrell created, along with Mark DeSalvatore, and developed a professional engineer review course after he realized several of their young engineers failed the examination process. They taught at lunch time for several weeks preparing staff for the CE licensing exam in soil mechanics and geotechnical engineering. In 1995 both were hired by the American Society of Civil Engineers Young Member Forum out of Sac State to teach the geotechnical engineering course for the CE License. Which they continued for 20 years.

Just prior to his retirement in August of 2020, Darrell received the very prestigious James E. Roberts Award for Outstanding Management and Engineering in Transportation for his body of work, dedication and contribution to the Department for over 35 years.

Darrell spent a lot of time doing other things as well. Occasionally associates would see a race car on a trailer in their parking lot behind the Geotechnical office, ready to go to the races. So, we are going to hear some fun things about Darrell's racing experience instead of that "boring" Engineering life.

But congratulations to Darrell for all he has accomplished in his career.


