JANUARY LUNCHEON CELEBRATION:

Len Kovar had his 95th birthday on October 24, 2017 and received his Super Senior Sir President's Award at the January 10th meeting. Len was indeed a member of the Greatest Generation.

After Officer training he became a bombardier/navigator. And after 10 successful combat missions, **Len Kova**r was shot down from his B-24 bomber over Hungary in the spring of 1944.

He was 22 years old. The next nine months were spent in prison or in forced marches across Germany in the **worst winter ever recorded.**

Patton's army arrived at **Len's** prison camp Stalag 7A, on April 13, 1945. He had survived. And we are all glad he did.
